Jolly Beach Resort is Antigua's Premier All-Inclusive Resort for Meeting Planners
-- Antigua Gives Meetings Tax Breaks to U.S. Companies --
-- Refurbishment Underway, Wi-Fi Access Now Available --

BOLAN'S VILLAGE, Antigua, W.I. (September 24, 2007) – In December 2001 the government of Antigua announced an agreement with the United States that provides a tax write-off for American companies holding meetings in Antigua & Barbuda. All-inclusive Jolly Beach Resort, home to Antigua's largest and most up-to-date meetings facilities -- and its longest stretch of white-sand beach on a 40-acre estate – welcomed this development as one more good reason to choose Jolly Beach Resort for any meeting or incentive group. Jolly Beach Resort is the island's premier resort for meeting planners. With over 8,000 square feet of meetings space the resort has state-of-the-art facilities catering to meetings of twenty to three hundred and fifty and improvements are underway.

The first meeting room to be refurbished is the 1,271 square foot Frangiapani. Improvements include the installation of a projector and speakers in the ceiling; sound proofing; data cables set in the newly carpeted floor; in-set lights with dimmers; emergency lighting and a secretariat. Final touches are being completed and the room will reopen on October 1, 2007.

The resort's meeting space also includes the 1,271 square foot Bougainvillea; 1,400 square foot Oleander room; and the Hibiscus, a 5,000 square foot conference space equipped with state-of-the-art multimedia projectors; television and DVD player; and a public address system. Hibiscus can be configured from U-shape for 50 people to theater style for 350 people.

Jolly Beach also offers the technological infrastructure required for the successful staging of any event including Wi-Fi access in all four of its conference rooms and is free for groups booked in for meetings. Wireless service is also available in two of the resort superior room blocks, the reception area, the courtyard and at the Quiet Pool for a small fee.

All 464 of the hotel's rooms are air-conditioned and have ocean views; each has a patio or balcony, direct-dial phone, cable TV, hair-dryer and safe. On the mile-long beach, Sunfish, Hobie Cats, wind-surfers, pedal boats, and kayaks are there for the asking. Four tennis courts,

two lit for night play, are presided over by a resident pro; table tennis is beachside and there are pool tables with a view. An 18-hole golf course is an easy walk next door -- while to get in shape for it all, there's a Fitness Center complete with professional Cybex equipment. The resort's Fantasy Pool features a waterfall, and the Quiet Pool is the perfect spot for some afternoon refreshment and a good book.

There are five restaurants at the resort: Lydia's, featuring seafood; Italian and Indian cuisine at Bocciole and Utsav respectively; the poolside Coconut Grill serving light fare, and an all-you-can-eat buffet called Hemispheres, open for all three meals. In addition, Chef Nigel Gore creates unforgettable special banquets for groups. In these times the resort's all-inclusive feature is especially attractive to organizers, and attendees are pleased by the wide range of menu options as they are with the variety of leisure activities.
